The McGeorge Women's Caucus (MWC) is a philanthropic law student organization that regularly hosts events in Sacramento on issues impacting women and children in the Sacramento region. Our charity auction is our largest annual event in the city of Sacramento and regularly has an attendance between 200 to 250 local attorneys, law professors, and law students.

The goal of the organization is to serve as a network between female attorneys in Sacramento and women who pursue a career in law at the McGeorge School of Law. The organization also focuses on empowering future women attorneys by building skills in leadership. Given your record of leadership on the Energy and Commerce Committee on issues impacting healthcare and the high-tech industry, we believe you would serve as an inspiration to young women pursuing a career in the field of law.
